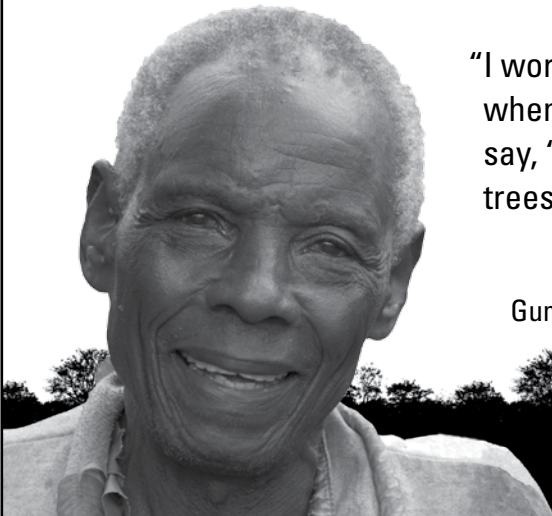
Fair Trade coffee is a simple solution that can mean the difference

credit and protect their environment.

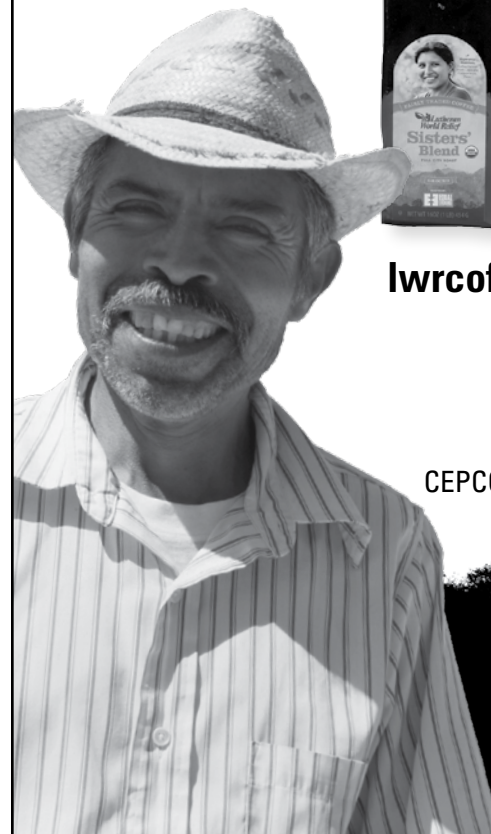
For each pound of coffee, tea, cocoa, sugar and snacks we buy
