Two years ago, you rushed to the aid of Ukrainian families who lost everything when war erupted in their homeland. And you've continued to support them every day since.

From mobile clinics that deliver lifesaving medical care ... to hot meals prepared with love ... from safe shelters built to last ... to comforting quilts stitched with care, you continue to reach your neighbors when, how and where they need help most.

I'm grateful to report to you that they feel your loving support.

Neighbors, like Natalia Chernenka, were comforted by the warmth of handmade quilts. When the Russians invaded, "they would bombard us with missiles as constant as fireworks," she said.

These violent missile attacks demolished their roof and ruined their makeshift tarp — leaving them totally exposed to the elements.

"This quilt is very important to us," Natalia shared. "Everything is destroyed, so at least we can cover ourselves. Thank you for not forgetting us."

To date, you've wrapped over 17,590 quilts around your Ukrainian neighbors!

In May, more than 6,000 of your neighbors in Kharkiv, Ukraine, received vegetable seeds, fertilizer, farming tools, chickens and more to restore or establish

small farms.

Additionally, families who fled violence and are now living in group shelters in Kharkiv, will receive support to start kitchen or backyard gardens to provide

We also worry about our elderly neighbors who could not flee and lost their loved ones. Many of their homes have been looted and occupied by enemy troops. They are isolated.

While others have forgotten our Ukrainian neighbors who feel alone and scared — you have not.

When our team is there delivering supplies, they are overwhelmed by gratitude from your Ukrainian sisters and brothers who want you to know they feel your love, saying, "Thank you for your prayers. Thank you for providing this food, this place to stay. **Thank you for remembering us.**"

Your Love Grows Community ... and Cocoa

You are cultivating sustainability and uplifting your neighbors in Ecuador.

Together, we've taken an innovative approach to cocoa production creating community plant nurseries! These nurseries are built to last and planted with love.



They also emphasize organic production. To date, no synthetic chemicals have been used on these hearty crops.

A group of San Isidro cocoa farmers — ranging in age from 30 to 60 — have strengthened Nacional cacao variety production by sharing the plants with fellow farmers.

An added bonus to the community nurseries is the preservation of the endangered Nacional cacao variety. After receiving critically needed technical advice, local cacao farmers now manage the nurseries and have successfully cultivated 11,000 Nacional cacao plants to share with fellow cacao farmers.

By extending your loving hand, you are uniting communities around cacao or — as it is known by your neighbors in Ecuador, the "pepa de oro" (golden bean) — and providing lasting incomes for God's children who need you. **Thank you.** ■
