You Help Harvest a Bountiful Future for Neighbors in Nepal

Nageswor's farm grows with his innovations! He's made a plow from an old bicycle and a cart constructed from parts of a broken wheelchair. These crafty tools show his resourcefulness but also reveal his struggle.

Nageswor can't afford to buy hardy seeds or new equipment for his farm. He and his beautiful family — which includes his wife Ram Bati, four daughters, two sons and a growing number of grandchildren — live in a poor, flood-prone region of Nepal.

While farmers need rain, living on the floodplain near the river is often destructive. Every monsoon season, the river flows, drowning crops.

Nageswor has tried other occupations over the years to make ends meet — like carpentry, masonry and bicycle repair — but nothing paid enough to feed his hungry children, cover education costs or pay for

medical care, which is especially frightening, because Nageswor is diabetic.

"To provide food, clothes, education for the children — we were really struggling with that," Nageswor recalls. "We did not have enough to meet all our basic needs."

Thankfully, your love planted seeds of hope and promise in Nageswor's heart. He received training

on flood safety and precautions to help keep his farm safe.

Your generous gifts also built a greenhouse and provided seeds and tips on what crops to grow outside of the rainy season.

Because you extended your caring hand to Nageswor, he can look at his growing farm and thriving family with pride. "Now I do not need to rely on others or stretch my hands to others for money," he says.

Because of caring friends of faith, like you, Marc is able to save lives and provide comfort and hope to neighbors in need.

Marc vs. the Volcano

Marc Bombite comes to the rescue time and time again for the women in his community, but the day he faced a volcano head-on, he rose to superhero status!

Marc is a medical transporter for health centers in the Democratic Republic of Congo. He faces danger daily — driving on tough terrain, navigating flooded, often impassable roads and being cautious of the civil unrest. No matter the obstacle, Marc keeps working through it.

"If I say, 'I'm tired. I'm not working,' how many people will die?" Marc ponders.

His medical supplies contain PEP Kits, which prevent HIV and other diseases and are given in the immediate aftermath of sexual assaults. In order for the kit to work, survivors must take the medicine within 72 hours of an attack to prevent disease.

When a survivor needs a kit, Marc delivers, no matter what.

During a recent volcano warning, Marc rode his motorbike to rescue kits from a warehouse and bring them to people in need, who'd been forced to flee. He saw the lava but took his chances anyway.

"We took the risk because the community needed us," he says. "We needed the kits. So, I worked."

Like Marc, you put the needs of your neighbors first — rushing to the front lines in time of need. Thank you. ■
