War, disasters and other emergencies affect everyone, but the world's poorest suffer most. That's why Lutheran World Relief is there to offer help and hope, wherever and whenever a crisis arises.

EMERGENCY FOOD PARCEL

In times of emergency, finding enough food can be nearly impossible. An emergency food parcel generally includes enough canned food items and rice to **feed a family for one week.** 

#### WATER PURIFICATION TABLETS + 10 BUCKETS

Water purification tablets can **prevent** waterborne illnesses like typhoid and cholera. One tablet dissolved in a bucket of water can be the difference between healthy hydration and debilitating illness.

### WOOD STOVE

\$300

Your gift of a wood stove can provide muchneeded **heat** and a safe place for preparing meals until power is restored. Stoves are a source of comfort and warmth for a family's home – and their hearts.

SOAP

When homes are destroyed or families must flee for safety, soap and a towel rarely make the cut for what they can carry. IWR Personal Care Kits provide critical germ fighting supplies and the chance to regain dignity amid fear and uncertainty. Learn more at lwr.org/kits.
