# AMBASSADOR FAQs

## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

Approximately 4-8 hours per month with a minimum commitment of 1 year.

## **WHAT SUPPORT WILL I RECEIVE FROM LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF?**

At the beginning of the program, you will attend an extensive training to learn more about LWR's programs and how to be an effective Ambassador. You will receive everything you need to do your work. In addition, LWR staff will host bi-monthly check-ins with all of our Ambassadors to provide training, updates and mutual support, as well as to receive feedback. Additionally, LWR Ambassadors will be invited to a special Facebook page dedicated to supporting one another and sharing ideas.

## **WHY DOES AN AMBASSADOR HAVE TO BE A FAITHFUL NEIGHBOR (MONTHLY DONOR)?**

An important part of an Ambassador's role is inviting others to be a Faithful Neighbor. As with any form of stewardship, it is important that you are willing to do what you are asking of others. But above and beyond that, sharing your love as a Faithful Neighbor puts you directly on the front lines of ministry along with our staff. Our neighbors need help now. Without your love and sustainable financial gift, our neighbors cannot receive the interventions they desperately need.

## **IS THERE A TRAVEL REQUIREMENT?**

When it is safe to travel, Ambassadors will be invited to travel to Baltimore or a central regional location for orientation. Ambassadors will also be invited to regional gatherings on an annual basis. Currently, however, there is no travel happening at LWR due to COVID-19. We look forward to the day travel will resume, but in the meantime orientation and meetings will be conducted via Zoom.
